SECRETARY'S REPORT 2019 SEASON

2019 was another busy season for the Coaching Society. Thankfully we have more Club Coaches now so in future it will not be so onerous for the previous Club Coaches, whose numbers have been steadily dwindling. Now we are very much on the up!!

In April we ran an Assistant Club Coach Seminar at Llandudno Bowling Club with ten participants from Llandudno, Craig y Don, Llysfaen and Caernarfon Bowling Clubs.

In July we ran another Assistant Club Coach Seminar, this time in Rhos on Sea with 8 participants from Rhos on Sea BC

We followed up with a Club Coach Seminar in Rhos on Sea in September, and those participants will be assessed early in the coming season, we wish them luck.

Several clubs now have Club Coaches and are now running training sessions, mainly for beginners and some specifically for children. Rhos on Sea BC run an Academy for adults and are working towards having sessions for people with disabilities, and have attended Disability Awareness training courses.
